SPECIFIC POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide support, consultation, assessment and treatment services 13 - 18 and their families using family, individual, parent-child, and group modalities as required.
- Provide outreach services and support to high school students in a variety of settings including but not limited to home, school, and office as directed by manager.
- Coordinate assigned cases, as appropriate.
- Provide a social work perspective within the multidisciplinary team and be aware of the importance of contributions from other disciplines in recognizing and treating disorders of children and their families.
- Demonstrate ability to work within the team to develop a coordinated treatment program to meet child and family needs.
- Liaise and advocate on behalf of the child and family to other staff members and to significant professionals and programs in the community.
- Be aware of and provide information on community needs to assist in planning for services and programs, both at ROCK and in the Halton community.
- Maintain documentation for cases as outlined in the case management system
- Act as a case manager to ensure that assigned cases for "high need" families requiring intensive supports are provided expedient access within their home and/or community.
- Provide services that will be sensitive to the cultural, linguistic and social diversity of families within the home, school, and/or community.
- Provide services which are flexible, responsive and accessible that are delivered in home, schools and in the local community.
- Use a variety of therapeutic intervention strategies including; instruction, modeling, parent support, individual family and group counseling
- Provide in home assistance to families requiring child management techniques, parenting skills, life skills and behavioural management programming
- Act as both an advocate and as a liaison for families with community agencies, schools, law enforcement, the medical community and other local service providers

- Provide opportunities for children and families to develop and maintain social relationships and community linkages
- Consult with other staff members as well as significant professionals and programs in the community regarding direction of IC&F services and/or appropriate service referrals
- Assist in the preparation of monthly statistics and year-end reports. Complete all administrative tasks, including input into the ROCK client database, in a timely fashion as required for both client and organizational purposes.
- Abide by the specific requirements of Section 28 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act as well as any further health and safety responsibilities as outlined in the agency policy and procedure documents.
- Other duties as may reasonably be assigned.

REQUIRED SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS

- Master of Social Work degree or equivalent from a recognized university and eligible for registration with the College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers and/or the College of Registered Psychotherapists of Ontario (CRPO).
- Minimum of three years clinical experience in family, individual and parent-child therapy, as well as some experience leading groups. It is expected that this experience will have included appropriate supervision.
- Strong interpersonal and interviewing skill; demonstrated ability to apply relevant knowledge and training to the assessment and treatment of children and their families.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal skills, organizational and administrative skills
- Sound decision making and problem-solving skills and proven ability to work independently.
- Strong case management skills.
- Evidence of a theoretical framework which guides clinical work and is compatible with the agency's approach and reflects an understanding of crisis theory.
- Current (within 3 months), clear criminal reference check with vulnerable sector search.
- Valid driver's license and availability of a road worthy vehicle on site during working hours.
