Then Coordinated Service
Planning may help.**

Coordinated Service Planning is for families of children and youth with multiple and/or complex special needs who are:

- A resident of Halton
- Under the age of 18 and young people between the ages of 18 and 21 who remain in school
- Receiving two or more services
- Feeling overwhelmed with coordinating services
- Have limited social/community supports

Coordinated Service Planning will provide seamless and family-centred service so that families will:

- Have one point of contact
- Not have to repeat their story
- Have one Coordinated Service Plan



Your Coordinated Service Planner will:

- Encourage all the agencies involved with your family to **work together as a team**
- Support identified goals and work to ensure that your needs and concerns are heard and respected
- Recommend services and funding resources that could be beneficial for your family
