RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide supervised intervention to children and youth with Autism
- Under the supervision of a Board Certified Behaviour Analyst (BCBA), use the principles of Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) to train families and service providers to address the needs that children/youth with ASD have in the areas of communication, social/interpersonal skills, daily living skills, behaviour management/self-regulation, play and leisure skills, vocational skills, etc.
- Operationalize client safety by adhering to established policies and guidelines that ensure consistency in the delivery of quality and safe care and, by identifying and reporting any client safety incidents
- Assist in the writing/ documentation of conference summaries, assessments, treatment plan reviews and discharges and team meeting minutes.
- Work alongside the placement supervisor to ensure clear and consistent communication about Placement requirements and activities
- Attend monthly ROCK Placement Student Lab
- Ensure compliance with the specific requirements of Section 28 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act as well as any further health and safety responsibilities as outlined in agency policy and procedure documents
- Other duties as may reasonably be assigned

Required Skills/Qualifications

- Applicants completing their Master's Degree in ABA or a related field are welcome to apply.
- Strong interpersonal skills.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a treatment team.
- Ability to work in person and virtually
