SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Co-facilitate weekly afternoon/evening group prevention programs
- Support the development of new programming with an emphasis on strengths based, anti-oppressive and anti-racist approaches to youth mental health.
- Research and develop resources and materials to support prevention programming.
- Provide affirming, inclusive and supportive experiences with youth to foster a sense of community.
- Complete case notes and attendance records following each group session and submit to Caseworks (ROCK's client database) in a timely fashion
- Work collaboratively with other students and staff
- Develop materials for social media distribution utilizing Canva
- Participate in outreach events in the community e.g., school or community presentations
- Participate in weekly supervision with Placement Supervisor
- Develop new workshops/initiatives for the community as directed by Supervisor
- Attend relevant orientations and trainings at ROCK
- Other duties may be reasonably assigned
